

Does a trunk optical cable need a ground plane



Overview

93 (A) requires technicians to ground any fiber optic cable at the point of entry to a building. While nonarmored fiber optic cables don't require grounding due to their nonconductive properties, grounding is crucial when using armored fiber optic cables. These cables include metallic components that can carry electrical currents, presenting potential hazards such as electrical shock or fire.
