

How to reserve space for fiber optic connector closures

Prep work starts with clearing telco closet space for a 19-inch rack or wall-mount enclosure, confirming 120V power at the equipment location, and making sure cable pathways (cable tray, conduit, j-hooks) are accessible from the service entry to every drop.
