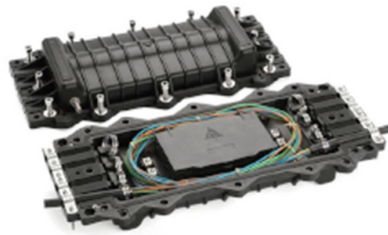


Parameters of underground optical cable conduit
