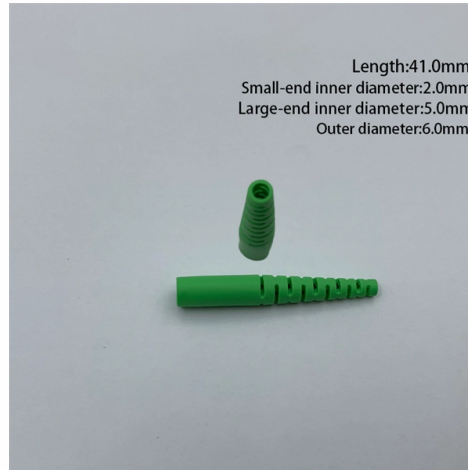


Precautions for fabricating cable tray elbows



Overview

The use and installation of cable trays is covered by legally enforceable OSHA regulations in 29 CFR 1910. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when the cable tray cont d for instrumentation and control applications that require.
