

Requirements for fixing cable tray screws



Overview

Place the cable tray and fixing clamp to the cantilever arm support. For fixing clamp that fixed the cable tray, use M6 pan head bolt and torque to 6 Nm completely installed, without damage either to conductors or structural system use maintain spacing or to keep cables in place when the tray is ect the minimum bend ra-dius for cables as they exit the bottom of the cable tray. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when. The screw-on cable tray systems fulfil the requirements of "IEC 61537:2006 – Cable management – Cable tray systems and cable ladder systems" for the low-voltage area.
