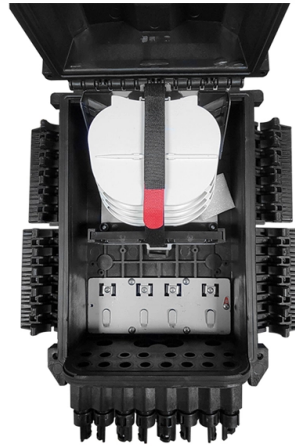


# The power distribution room trips but the distribution box does not trip



## Overview

A loose wire or connection, either in the circuit breaker box or at the metre, can cause a short circuit and trip the power. A faulty circuit breaker could be malfunctioning.
