Overview

The Prime Minister of Uzbekistan organizes and directs the activities of the Cabinet of Ministers, is personally responsible for its effective operation, presides over meetings of the Cabinet of Ministers, and signs its decisions. The Cabinet of Ministers has the right of legislative initiative. The President of Uzbekistan has the right to make decisions on issues within the competence of the Cabinet of Ministers. Overview Cabinet of Ministers of Uzbekistan (: O'zbekiston Respublikasi Vazirlar Mahkamasi) is the country's executive body, ensuring the effective functioning of the economy, social and spiritual spheres, and the implementation of the state policy. The Cabinet of Ministers as Uzbekistan's executive branch of the government was created in 1992 following the independence of the country and the adoption of the Constitution. On June 12, 2017, the President of Uzbekistan signed the Law on the Cabinet of Ministers. The Cabinet of Ministers consists of the Prime Minister of Uzbekistan, his deputies, and chairmen of state committees. The head of the government of the country is part of the Cabinet of Ministers.
