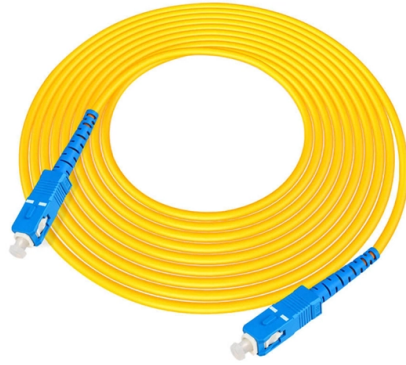


What modules should be connected to the optical port of the switch
