

# Where to put the electrical distribution box in a residential building

Choose the right box based on environment (indoor/outdoor), load capacity, and durability. Check for proper IP/NEMA ratings and material quality. To find it quickly, look for a rectangular gray metal box about the size of a medicine cabinet, often positioned close to.
